  - Please bring flashlights to use during the show









## **DIRECTOR'S NOTES**


I WAS VERY EXCITED ABOUT THE POSSIBILITIES for a Hallowe'en show when playwright Paul Braunstein first approached me with the idea of him creating such a show for 4th Line. Paul pitched an idea which would be similar to Caravan Farm Theatre's Walk of Terror, an annual fall event on their farm theatre site in B.C. Paul originally thought we would do the show at our farm site. And while I was intrigued by that possibility, I was more interested in setting the play in Millbrook and exploring the buildings, paths and streets of the village. Paul, and his co-playwright Monica Dottor, quickly got excited about the possibilities of a walking play set in Millbrook. Through a series of reminiscences, gathering of local stories and talks with long-time residents, they have created a play which is genuinely creepy and full of true local stories of the supernatural and ghosts. The show debuted in 2016, it sold-out before we opened! The response to the play was overwhelmingly positive, and we knew we had to bring it back. At its heart, *The Shadow Walk* is a play about searching for understanding and meaning in one's life. Our paranormal investigator is on a quest to recapture something lost in his childhood. Or perhaps the piece is about recapturing the lost innocence of childhood. Many people who are believers in the paranormal believe that children are the most open to seeing or sensing spirits and ghosts because they have not closed themselves off, the way many adults have. Both in 2016 and again this year, I have been thinking a lot about my own questions about the existence of spectres. Through this process, I have come to believe that the existence of other planes of reality and of spirits caught between our plane and others, is a very real possibility. I am excited to share The Shadow Walk of Millbrook with you and see if you are a believer by the end of the night.



One, The Walk of Terror that Caravan Farm Theatre does every year in B.C. where the audience walks around the property and has to pass some scary installations and, secondly, Common Boots Theatre's Christmas shows at Evergreen Brickworks where the audience travels around as a story unfolds. Part event, part theatrical experience, and audiences always seem to love it. We wanted to create a multidisciplinary show - a sensory journey for the audience with elements of theatre, dance, music and circus arts bringing the town's local history to life in a spooky and entertaining fashion. ## Kim Blackwell, Managing Artistic Director, Director

Kim is a veteran 4th Line director/ producer - 2018 marks her 24th season with 4th Line Theatre where she has directed 17 productions including eight world premieres. Selected credits include: Artistic Director (2014 -Present), Artistic Producer (2009 -2014), Artistic Associate (2001-2009), directing: Who Killed Snow White? (2018), The Shadow Walk of Millbrook (2016), The Hero of Hunter Street (2016), The Bad Luck Bank Robbers (2015, 2016), The Real McCoy (2013), Queen Marie, St. Francis of Millbrook (2012), The Berlin Blues (2011), The Right Road to Pontypool (2009, 2010), Schoolhouse (2007, 2008), The Art of Silent Killing, That Summer, Crow Hill, The Cavan Blazers, Attrition, Gimme That Prime Time Religion and many development workshops; stage managing: The Cavan Blazers, Crow Hill, 1837: The Farmer's Revolt, Moodie Traill, The Farm Show, Stone Angel, Winslows of Derryvore, The Orchard. Kim recently directed Maja Ardal's *HER2*, a Nightwood/Buddies in Bad Times Theatre co-production, Pocket Rocket (Lost and Found Theatre), Les Soeurs (The Sisters) at Erring 2014 and Chicken Grease is Nasty Business at the Summerworks Festival for which she received a NOW Magazine nod for Outstanding Direction. Selected other directing credits include Once A Flame, Fire in the Stable, The Shadow of Genius (Heritage Pavilion); Getting Lucky (Rhubarb!, 2005); Unlucky (Summerworks, 2003); The Ugly Man; Goodnight Desdemona (Good Morning Juliet); Poor Super Man; Unidentified Human Remains... She also directed

a sold-out run of Freedom 85! in the 2008 Fringe Festival and at the 2009 New York City Frigid Festival where it received excellent critical attention and the Audience Choice Award and the See It Twice Award. She was nominated for the John Hirsch Award for Directing Excellence in 2009 (Canada Council) and 2014 (Ontario Arts Council). She was the winner of a 2013 KETS Award for "People Who Rock Our World." She was the only Canadian invited to train with Felix Barrett, the renowned Artistic Director of Punchdrunk (Sleep No *More*) in his immersive and promenade theatre style. Kim was inducted into Peterborough's Pathway of Fame in September 2016.



## Paul Braunstein, Co-playwright

Paul Braunstein has worked in film, television, radio and theatre for over 25 years. Recently Paul was seen in *Bad Luck Bank Robbers* at 4th Line. Current TV work includes CBC's "Baroness von Sketch Show" and "Burden of Truth." As well as "October Faction" coming this year for Netflix. 
4th Line Theatre is where Art and Community meet
